## NEW - \$20 Curl Regina Capital Improvement Fee

In an effort to ensure the future of curling in the city, Curl Regina in agreement with its three curling club members has initiated an annual \$20 Capital Improvement Fee. The purpose of this will allow for the clubs to formulate a 5-year capital improvement plan, for building, plant and other capital expenditures. Curl Regina has established guidelines to ensure the money collected is being used to improve the quality and longevity of the facilities. The funds collected will stay within each respective club and a Curl Regina 10% Facility Improvement Top Up Grant will be provided to each club that has abided by the guidelines for collection and expenditures.

The Capital Improvement fee will be paid by every curler that curls in a weekly league in Regina and is subject to the GST. Each person will only pay the fee once within the city. Receipts will be issued and must be presented to the second and third club to ensure the fee is collected only once. The fee is applicable to all ages, and all leagues, including commercial leagues. In an effort to continue to support the future of the sport, Curl Regina will pay the \$20 fee to the appropriate club for each Curl for Kids and Youth League participant.

The future of our great sport depends on the existence of safe and attractive curling facilities. This is an investment in the future, so we can all continue to enjoy curling for decades to come.
